**ORDER AUTHORIZING BLOCK
NONRENEWAL**

On or about June 23, 2017, the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Department”) received from SECURIAN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY (“SECURIAN”) a notification of SECURIAN’s intent to discontinue offering and to block nonrenew its group dental insurance policies delivered or issued for delivery in Idaho. SECURIAN represented that the contemplated block nonrenewal will affect approximately eight (8) group policies covering approximately one hundred fifty-one (151) individual insureds. SECURIAN further represented that the affected policies will be nonrenewed at their natural expiration date, and that SECURIAN will provide affected plan sponsors notice of the nonrenewal at least one hundred eighty (180) days in advance of the nonrenewal effective date.

The Director, having reviewed the foregoing and the requirements of Idaho Code § 41-1841(1), and acting pursuant to the authority set forth in Idaho Code § 41-210(2),

THE DIRECTOR HEREBY FINDS that the proposed effective date of the contemplated block nonrenewal complies with the one hundred twenty (120) day notice requirement to the Director, as set forth in Idaho Code § 41-1841(1).

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that SECURIAN is authorized, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1841, to effectuate a block nonrenewal of its group dental insurance policies delivered or issued for delivery in Idaho, which, based on SECURIAN's representation, will affect approximately eight (8) group policies covering approximately one hundred fifty-one (151) individual insureds. SECURIAN shall begin nonrenewing the affected policies at each policy's natural expiration date occurring on or after one hundred eighty (180) days from the date of SECURIAN's written notice to affected plan sponsors, as set forth by SECURIAN in its notice to the Department. SECURIAN's notice shall be provided in accordance with Idaho law and with the notice provisions included in the company's applicable insurance policies.

THIS ORDER is a final order of the Director and is EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This Order constitutes a final order of the Director. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The Director will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See*, Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal it by filing a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) the hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the aggrieved party resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency decision is located. An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order; or (b) an order denying a petition for reconsideration; or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See*, Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.
