ORDER TERMINATING DEVIATION FROM 2017 WORKERS' COMPENSATION RATES AND PERMITTING DEVIATION FROM 2018 WORKERS' COMPENSATION RATES

ILLINOIS INSURANCE COMPANY ("ILLINOIS") is an Iowa-domiciled insurer licensed to transact workers' compensation insurance in the state of Idaho pursuant to Certificate of Authority No. 2808 and is a member of the National Council on Compensation Insurance, Inc. ("NCCI").

On May 31, 2017, in accordance with ILLINOIS' request, the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (Director) issued an order in Docket No. 18-3328-17, authorizing ILLINOIS to deviate from the workers' compensation rates filed by the NCCI for 2017. Pursuant to such order, the 2017 rate deviation became effective on June 1, 2017, and was to remain in

effect for one year, i.e., until May 31, 2018, unless terminated sooner with the approval of the

Director.

On or about October 20, 2017, the Idaho Department of Insurance (Department) received

from ILLINOIS a request for permission to withdraw the rate deviation authorized by the

Director's order in Docket No. 18-3328-17, effective December 31, 2017, and to deviate from the

workers' compensation rates filed by the NCCI for 2017 by a uniform percentage decrease of ten

percent (10%), effective January 1, 2018.

ILLINOIS and the NCCI have each waived their right to a hearing on the deviation request.

The Director, having reviewed and being fully apprised of ILLINOIS' request and of the

requirements of Idaho Code § 41-1614, has determined that the request is justified.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that ILLINOIS' current rate deviation,

as authorized by the Director's order in Docket No. 18-3328-17, shall terminate effective at

midnight on December 31, 2017.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1614, that ILLINOIS' request

to deviate by a uniform percentage decrease of ten percent (10%) from the workers' compensation

rates filed by the NCCI for 2018, exclusive of terrorism and catastrophe rating values, is

GRANTED. This deviation from the Idaho workers' compensation premium rates filed by the

NCCI for 2018 shall take effect on January 1, 2018, and shall remain in effect for one year from

that date unless terminated sooner with the approval of the Director.
