**STIPULATION and
FINAL ORDER**

The parties herein, the Idaho Department of Insurance (Department) and Jamison Hook (RESPONDENT), do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

1. The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Director") has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to title 41, Idaho Code.
2. RESPONDENT is a resident of the state of Washington.
3. RESPONDENT submitted an Application to the Department for a nonresident producer license on or about December 18, 2014 (the "Application").
4. On the Application question asking whether RESPONDENT had ever been convicted of a misdemeanor, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or was currently charged with

committing a misdemeanor, the response was marked, "No."

5. RESPONDENT was issued Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 513725 on December 23, 2014, pursuant to chapter 10, title 41, Idaho Code. RESPONDENT's Idaho nonresident producer license remains active.

6. In November of 2017, RESPONDENT contacted the Department and asked to add a qualification for the variable line of authority to his Idaho license.

7. In processing RESPONDENT's request, the Department obtained a FINRA BrokerCheck report, which contained information concerning a criminal matter involving RESPONDENT from 2006.

8. In response to an email inquiry from the Department, RESPONDENT provided information that showed that RESPONDENT pled guilty to a misdemeanor arising from an arrest in 2005. Through further investigation, the Department discovered that RESPONDENT had pled guilty to an additional misdemeanor arising from an arrest in 2003. Neither of these misdemeanor convictions were disclosed on RESPONDENT's nonresident producer application.

9. The Department alleges that RESPONDENT is in violation of Idaho Code § 41-1016(1)(a) for failing to disclose his misdemeanor convictions and thereby providing incorrect and materially untrue information in his Idaho license application.

10. In consideration of the foregoing, the parties stipulate and agree as follows:

- a. That RESPONDENT admits to having violated Idaho Code § 41-1016(1)(a) by failing to disclose his misdemeanor convictions and thereby providing incorrect and materially untrue information in his Idaho license application;
- b. That an administrative penalty of \$250 shall be imposed against RESPONDENT;

- c. That the \$250 administrative penalty shall be paid in full within ten (10) days from the date the Final Order herein is executed by the Director; and
- d. That a Final Order setting forth the foregoing may be entered by the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance.

11. The parties agree that the terms of this Stipulation and Final Order are appropriate and proper under the circumstances referenced herein.

12. By entering into this Stipulation, RESPONDENT knowingly and voluntarily waives any rights he would otherwise have to notice and a hearing at which he may be represented by counsel, present evidence, and examine witnesses. The parties hereto further waive their right of reconsideration, appeal, and other rights as set forth in title 67, chapter 52, Idaho Code, including the right to submit this matter for review by a court of competent jurisdiction.

13. RESPONDENT acknowledges that he has read this Stipulation and Final Order and understands its contents; that he has been given the opportunity to discuss this Stipulation and Final Order with legal counsel of his choosing; and that he has entered into this Stipulation knowingly, voluntarily, and with full knowledge of any rights he may be waiving thereby.

14. RESPONDENT acknowledges that this is an administrative action that may be required to be reported on license applications and license renewal forms and disclosed to other jurisdictions in which RESPONDENT holds a license.

15. This Stipulation is subject to approval by the Director or the Director's designee, and shall become effective and binding upon the Department and RESPONDENT upon such approval. Should the Director decline to approve this Stipulation and Final Order, the Department and RESPONDENT shall retain all of their rights, claims and/or defenses, and any factual and/or legal admissions made by RESPONDENT herein shall be withdrawn.

16. This Stipulation constitutes the full and final resolution of all violations alleged in Docket No. 18-3413-17, and the Department agrees that, subject to the Director's approval described in Paragraph 15, and RESPONDENT's compliance with the terms of the Stipulation, the Department shall seek no further sanctions for the violations alleged herein.


17. This Stipulation and Final Order embodies the entire agreement between the Department and RESPONDENT, and there are no agreements, understandings, representations, or warranties that are not expressly set forth herein.

18. Upon the Director's entry of the Final Order approving this stipulation, this Stipulation and Final Order shall be a public record under the Idaho Public Records Act.

19. The parties hereto have reviewed the proposed Final Order and agree as to its form and that said Final Order may be submitted to the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance for his review and signature.

IT IS SO AGREED.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an administrative penalty in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) is imposed against JAMISON HOOK; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the foregoing administrative penalty imposed against JAMISON HOOK shall be paid in full within ten (10) days from the date this Final Order is executed by the Director.
