**STIPULATION AND ORDER
FOR ISSUANCE OF PRODUCER
LICENSE**

STIPULATION

COME NOW the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Department”) and Julie Ann Butterfield (“BUTTERFIELD”) and do hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. The Director of the Department has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to title 41, Idaho Code.
2. On or about March 15, 2018, the Department received from BUTTERFIELD an application for an Idaho Resident Insurance Producer License (“Application”).

3. BUTTERFIELD disclosed and provided documentation with her Application, and in subsequent communication with the Department, indicating that she is the subject of a judgment for court costs and fines payable to the State of Idaho ("Judgment"). Such Judgment resulted from an Order of Unsatisfactory Discharge from Probation and Judgment entered against BUTTERFIELD on May 31, 2006, in the Seventh Judicial District of Idaho, County of Bonneville, in Case No. CR-99-2255, in the amount of \$9,661.75. BUTTERFIELD provided to the Department documentation demonstrating that, as of February 27, 2018, the balance of the Judgment is \$2,813.02.

4. BUTTERFIELD is currently employed by Blue Cross of Idaho, an insurer duly authorized to transact insurance in the state of Idaho.

5. Upon review of BUTTERFIELD's Application and related documents provided to the Department, the Department is willing to issue a resident insurance producer license to BUTTERFIELD on a provisional basis, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a. BUTTERFIELD agrees that, no later than six (6) months after entry of the Order herein, and continuing every six (6) months thereafter until such time as the Judgment is paid in full, BUTTERFIELD shall report and provide documentation to the Department demonstrating that she is current in her payments on the Judgment and reflecting the outstanding balance owed on the Judgment.
- b. BUTTERFIELD agrees that she shall report in writing to the Department's Licensing Section any change in her employment status or employer within ten (10) days of such change.
- c. The parties agree that BUTTERFIELD's failure to report as herein required or her failure to remain current in her payments on the Judgment shall result in

immediate revocation of BUTTERFIELD's resident insurance producer license without prior notice or hearing.

6. The parties agree that the terms of this Stipulation are appropriate and proper under the circumstances referenced herein, and that they have entered into this Stipulation knowingly, voluntarily and with full knowledge of any rights they may be waiving thereby.

7. Before executing this Stipulation, the parties have had the opportunity to review this Stipulation with their respective attorneys and to seek appropriate advice and counsel relating to this Stipulation and Order.

8. The parties waive their right to notice and hearing at which they may be represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. The parties further waive their right of reconsideration, appeal, and other rights as set forth in title 41 and title 67, chapter 52, Idaho Code, including the right to submit this matter for review by a court of competent jurisdiction.

9. This Stipulation is subject to approval by the Director or the Director's designee, and shall become effective and binding upon the Department and BUTTERFIELD upon such approval. Should the Director decline to approve this Stipulation, the Department and BUTTERFIELD shall retain all of their rights, claims and/or defenses, and any factual and/or legal admissions made by BUTTERFIELD herein shall be withdrawn.

10. This Stipulation embodies the entire agreement between the Department and BUTTERFIELD, and there are no agreements, understandings, representations or warranties that are not expressly set forth herein.

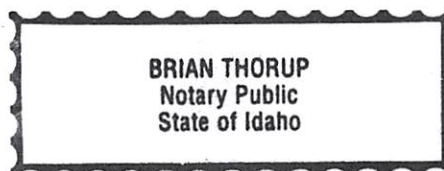

FINAL ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

4. That JULIE ANN BUTTERFIELD shall report in writing to the Department's Licensing Section any change in her employment status or employer within ten (10) days of such change; and
5. That JULIE ANN BUTTERFIELD's failure to report as ordered herein or her failure to remain current in her payments on the Judgment shall result in immediate revocation of JULIE ANN BUTTERFIELD's resident insurance producer license without prior notice or hearing.
