**ORDER AUTHORIZING
WITHDRAWAL FROM MEDICARE
SUPPLEMENT MARKET**

On or about February 11, 2019, the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Department”) received notice of the intent of AETNA LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY (“AETNA”) to withdraw from the Medicare Supplement market in Idaho, effective March 19, 2019, by discontinuing the availability of its Medicare Supplement plans, which AETNA identified as GPHMSP13A ID; GPHMSP13B ID; GPHMSP13F ID; GPHMSP13G ID; and GPHMSP13N ID.

AETNA acknowledged that its withdrawal of Medicare Supplement policies from sale in Idaho will prohibit AETNA from filing for approval in Idaho a new policy form or certificate form of the same type for the same standard Medicare Supplement benefit plans as the discontinued forms for a period of five (5) years from the date of AETNA’s notice to the Department, pursuant

to the requirements of IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04.b. AETNA represented that it will continue to service all of its existing in-force Medicare Supplement policies covering Idaho insureds, which policies are guaranteed renewable and will continue to provide coverage so long as premiums are paid when due.

AETNA's notice of intent to withdraw from the Medicare Supplement market in Idaho appears to comply with the notice requirements to the Department's Director ("Director") as set forth in IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04.a.

The Director, having reviewed the foregoing and the requirements of IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04, and good cause appearing therefor,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04.a, that AETNA is authorized to withdraw from the Medicare Supplement market in Idaho, effective March 19, 2019.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04.b, that AETNA shall not file with the Department a new policy form or certificate form of the same type for the same standard Medicare Supplement benefit plans as the discontinued forms prior to February 11, 2024.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
