**ORDER TERMINATING DEVIATION
FROM 2020 WORKERS'
COMPENSATION RATES,
EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020**

IDAHO STATE INSURANCE FUND (“ISIF”) is an Idaho-domiciled insurer licensed to transact workers’ compensation insurance in the state of Idaho pursuant to Certificate of Authority No. 1924 and is a member of the National Council on Compensation Insurance, Inc. (“NCCI”).

On November 13, 2019, in accordance with ISIF’s request, the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Director”) issued an order in the above-entitled docket, authorizing ISIF to deviate from the workers’ compensation rates filed by the NCCI for 2020. Pursuant to such order, the 2020 rate deviation became effective on January 1, 2020, and was to remain in effect for one year, unless terminated sooner with the approval of the Director.

On or about January 21, 2020, the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Department”) received from ISIF a request for permission to terminate the previously approved rate deviation, effective July 1, 2020, and to accept and apply the workers’ compensation rates filed by the NCCI for 2020 for all new and renewing policies beginning July 1, 2020.

ISIF and the NCCI have each waived their right to a hearing on this deviation request.

The Director, having reviewed and being fully apprised of ISIF's request and of the requirements of Idaho Code § 41-1614, has determined that the request is justified.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that ISIF's current rate deviation, as authorized by the Director's order issued in the above docket on November 13, 2019, shall terminate effective July 1, 2020, and that ISIF shall utilize and apply the workers' compensation rates filed by the NCCI for 2020 for all new and renewing policies beginning July 1, 2020.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Any such motion for reconsideration shall be served on the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance, addressed as follows:

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
