**SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING
IDAHO NONRESIDENT INSURANCE
PRODUCER LICENSE**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Director”) has received notice of the entry of an order by the Director of the Arizona Department of Insurance suspending the Arizona resident insurance producer license issued to KENNETH TOBY PULSIPHER (“PULSIPHER”), as further described below. Upon review of such order, and, pursuant to the authority granted by Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a), the Director does hereby make the following findings and enter a Summary Order as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. PULSIPHER, at all times relevant hereto, was licensed as a resident insurance producer in the state of Arizona.

2. On or about October 18, 2019, PULSIPHER agreed to the entry of a Consent Order by the Director of the Arizona Department of Insurance, in Matter No. 19A-153-INS, suspending PULSIPHER’s Arizona resident insurance producer license, based on PULSIPHER’s violation of Arizona law, including the improper withholding, misappropriating or converting of monies received in the course of doing insurance business. Such Consent Order was entered on or about

October 24, 2019, and provided for suspension of PULSIPHER's resident insurance producer license from November 2, 2019, through December 31, 2019, as well as for revocation of the insurance license of Aviation Management & Insurance, LLC, an entity for which PULSIPHER was the sole member and designated responsible licensed producer.

3. To date, PULSIPHER's Arizona resident insurance producer license has not been reinstated and remains in suspended status.

4. PULSIPHER is licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer, holding license number 331777, which is due to expire on February 28, 2021.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than twelve (12) months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state. Based on the foregoing, the Director finds that the circumstances set forth above justify the revocation of PULSIPHER's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 331777 issued to PULSIPHER is hereby REVOKED effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1027(1), that PULSIPHER shall immediately return Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 331777 to the Idaho Department of Insurance at the following address: 700 West State Street, P.O. Box 83720, Boise, Idaho, 83720-0043.

NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

This is considered a reportable administrative proceeding. Be aware that this proceeding must be disclosed on any license application and must be reported to any and all states in which you hold an insurance license.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Any such motion for reconsideration shall be served on the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance, addressed as follows:

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
