**SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING
IDAHO NONRESIDENT
INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (Director) has been apprised that BRANDON A. LEWANDOWSKI's Ohio resident insurance producer license has lapsed. Accordingly, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2), the Director enters this Summary Order revoking LEWANDOWSKI's Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 576197.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. According to records maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners and by the Ohio Department of Insurance, LEWANDOWSKI was licensed as a resident insurance producer in his home state of Ohio until his license lapsed on October 1, 2020, due to nonrenewal.

2. The Director has not received notification that LEWANDOWSKI has been relicensed as a resident in any other state.

3. Since June 16, 2016, LEWANDOWSKI has been continuously licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 576197.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(b)(ii) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than twelve (12) months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any nonresident insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the nonresident no longer has a license in the licensee's home state because the home state license was "nonrenewed by the nonresident and remains nonrenewed for a period greater than ninety (90) days beyond its expiration date, and without notice to the director of relicensing as a resident in another state."

5. The Director finds these circumstances justify the revocation of LEWANDOWSKI's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license under Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(b)(ii).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 576197 issued to LEWANDOWSKI is REVOKED, effective immediately.

NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

This is considered a reportable administrative proceeding. Be aware that this proceeding must be disclosed on any license application and must be reported to any and all states in which you hold an insurance license.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;

- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
