ORDER ON MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

On July 1, 2021, the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Director") issued an order continuing suspension of Certificate of Authority No. 3584 issued to AMERICAN SERVICE INSURANCE COMPANY, INC. ("American Service"), based on entry of an Agreed Order of Liquidation with a Finding of Insolvency by the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois, County Department, Chancery Division, in Case No. 19 CH 7852 (the "Circuit Court Order").

On July 14, 2021, American Service moved the Director for reconsideration of the suspension order. American Service asserted that, instead of placing American Service into liquidation, the Circuit Court Order separated American Service from its assets and sold the remainder of the company to Buckle Corp. ("Buckle"). Buckle then re-capitalized American Service and resumed business.

Upon further examination of the docket in the Illinois matter, the Director finds that, subsequent to entry of the Circuit Court Order, the court entered another order on or about

November 4, 2020, separating American Service into two different entities: American Service,

which existed only on paper and consisted of American Service's corporate charter and state

licenses; and the Liquidation Estate of American Service, which held all American Service's other

assets. Buckle won the bidding for American Service and acquired the company.

American Service's motion for reconsideration and the circuit court docket in the Illinois

matter demonstrate that the sale of American Service to Buckle closed on or about May 10, 2021,

and that, therefore, American Service was not subject to liquidation on July 1, 2021. While the

Director is disappointed that American Service did not keep him apprised of the status of its

liquidation and acquisition proceedings, the Director finds that grounds exist to vacate the July 1,

2021, order continuing suspension of American Service's Idaho certificate of authority and to

reinstate Idaho Certificate of Authority No. 3584.

THEREFORE, the Director's order of July 1, 2021, is VACATED. American Service is

instructed to contact the Idaho Department of Insurance Company Activities Bureau to complete

any applicable change of control documentation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Idaho Certificate of Authority No. 3584 issued to

American Service is reinstated effective immediately.

## NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Any such motion for reconsideration shall be served on the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance, addressed as follows:

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
