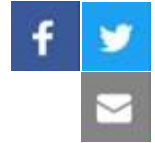

## **Medicare Workshops to be offered in Lewiston**

**BOISE ID** – Two free Medicare Workshops for individuals turning 65 and those approaching Medicare eligibility will be held in Lewiston on July 24<sup>th</sup>. The first workshop in Lewiston will be held from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Community Action Partnership of Lewiston, 124 New 6<sup>th</sup> St. The second workshop in Lewiston will be held from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the St. Joseph Regional Medical Center in Conference Room D, 415 6<sup>th</sup> St. Everyone, including caregivers, interested in learning how Medicare works is encouraged to attend.

Medicare workshops are designed to introduce the various parts of Medicare and to share some of the costs and benefits associated with the program. Sessions cover enrollment timeframes for Medigap, Medicare Advantage, prescription drug plans, and how the different parts of Medicare work together.
