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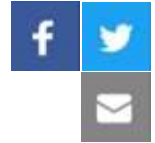

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Medicare Workshop to be Offered in Coeur d'Alene

BOISE ID – A free Medicare Workshop for individuals turning 65 and those approaching Medicare eligibility will be held in Coeur d'Alene on Tuesday, August 27th from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. at the Kroc Center, 1765 Golf Course Road. Everyone, including caregivers, interested in learning how Medicare works is encouraged to attend.

Medicare workshops are designed to introduce the various parts of Medicare and to share some of the costs and benefits associated with the program. Sessions cover enrollment timeframes for Medigap, Medicare Advantage, prescription drug plans, and how the different parts of Medicare work together.
