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Medicare open enrollment ends December 7th

BOISE, ID – Medicare open enrollment ends December 7th, 2020.

For those seeking to enroll in new Medicare plans as well as those with Medicare looking to make changes to existing Prescription Drug or Medicare Advantage plans, the annual open enrollment period begins October 15th and ends December 7th.

Senior Health Insurance Benefits Advisors (SHIBA) from the Idaho Department of insurance are available to talk with Medicare beneficiaries and those eligible to join the federal health care program. SHIBA representatives can provide free Medicare information, including reviewing Medicare coverage options.
