Dear Governor Little,

I present to you the 2025 State Fire Marshal's Annual Report. This report includes data and information collected and organized from fire service providers, including municipal fire departments, fire districts, and fire protection associations throughout Idaho.

The United States Fire Administration has transitioned to a new national reporting system. In 2025, fire departments across the country experienced a hybrid reporting year as they completed onboarding from the National Fire Incident Reporting System (NFIRS) into the new platform, National Emergency Response Information System (NERIS). This report reflects only the data submitted through the National Fire Incident Reporting System (NFIRS). Of the 233 organized fire service providers, 167 submitted their data to NFIRS.

The National Emergency Response Information System (NERIS) is designed to be more intuitive and to capture more detailed information on fire incidents, including lithium battery fires, fire detection performance, and other criteria important to the fire service nationwide. This is the first major upgrade to the national fire data collection system since its inception in the 1970s, following the National Commission on Fire Prevention and Control's "America Burning" report commissioned by President Richard Nixon.

This transition will be a learning process for Idaho's fire service and for our office. However, we are encouraged by the increased level of detail that will now be available for comparison and research. The enhanced data will also support laboratory testing, analysis of fire causes, and the identification of defects in consumer products—ultimately contributing to a safer Idaho.

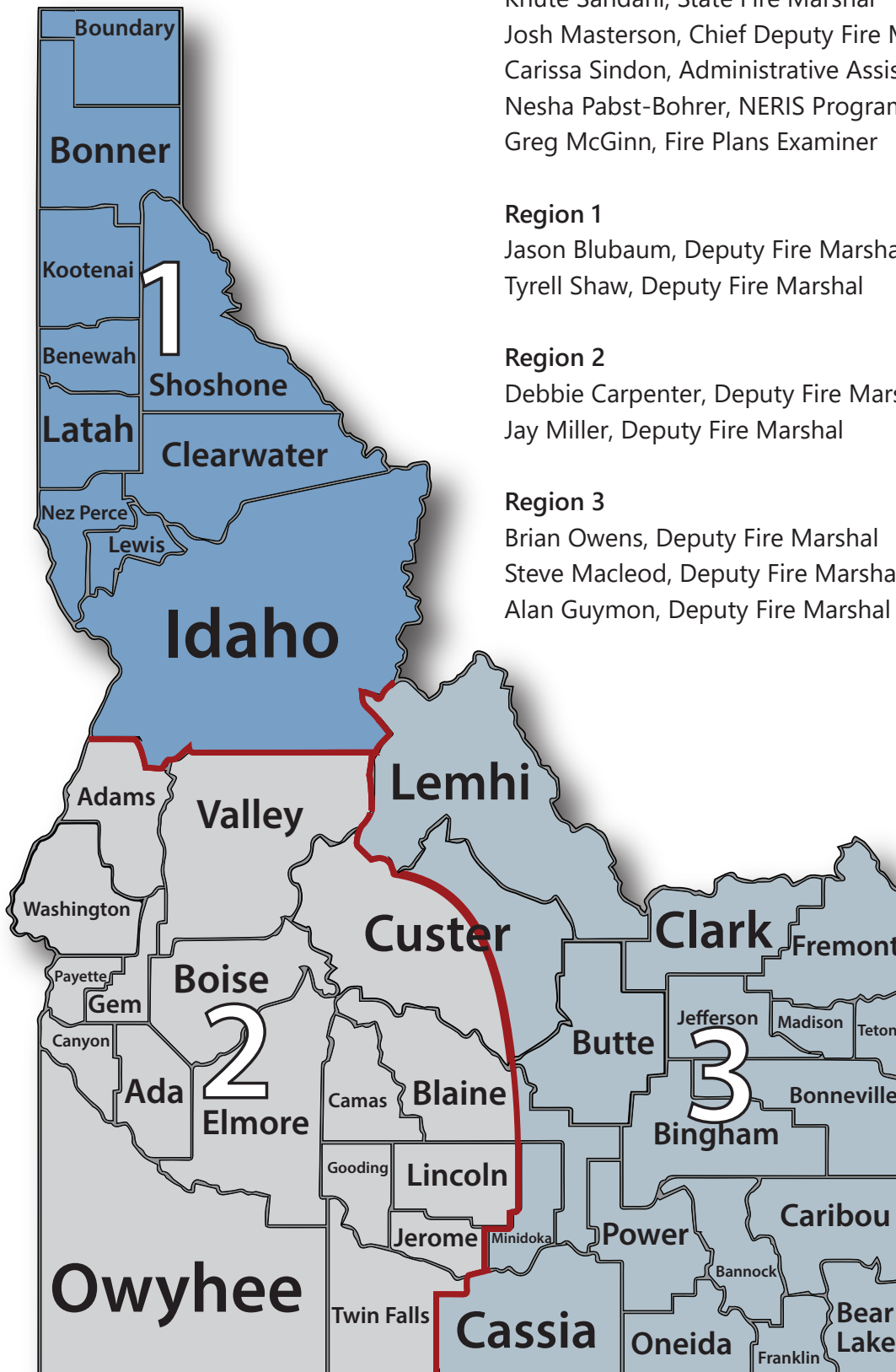
We continue to strengthen our partnership with the Idaho Department of Lands, the Idaho Office of Emergency Management, the Idaho Fire Chiefs Association, and the Idaho Sheriff's Association to establish standardized terminology for issuing evacuation orders during emergency incidents. In addition, we have taken a lead role in identifying and documenting losses resulting from catastrophic fire events.

We also remain in close collaboration with Director Cameron on initiatives aimed at helping Idaho homeowners maintain insurability and implement structural hardening measures to reduce vulnerabilities to wildfire. These efforts collectively enhance statewide resilience and support a unified approach to fire prevention and emergency response.

Mission Statement

The State Fire Marshal's Office participates in and coordinates an integrated statewide system designed to protect human life from fire and explosions through fire prevention, investigation, and public education activities. The system also includes code enforcement, the operation of the National Fire Incident Reporting System, and assistance to local fire agencies throughout the state.

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ABOUT THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE

Our dedicated staff works with a broad spectrum of customers in both the public and private sectors.

By statute, we are responsible for:

- Adoption of the International Fire Code for the state.
- Prescribe regulations and promulgate rules pertaining to the fire code.
- Review and approve plans for all state buildings for compliance with adopted fire codes.
- Inspect and test new fire sprinkler protection systems and fire alarm systems in all state buildings.
- Collect incident reports on emergency responses from fire departments.
- License Fire Protection Sprinkler Contractors.
- Review and approve plans for single service fire sprinkler systems.
- License fireworks wholesale and import businesses.
- Certify cigarette products per the Idaho Reduced Cigarette Ignition Propensity Law.
- Train local authorities to use and apply the fire code.
- Serve as a level for local appeal procedure by Idaho State Statute.
- The Chief Arson Investigation Officer in the State of Idaho.

We also..

- Assist local fire jurisdictions with plan reviews, inspections, and code interpretation.
- Conduct classes in fire investigation, code application, and incident reporting.
- Answer questions and providing statistical research for:

TRAINING OFFERED

FIRE INSPECTION 101

Learn the principles and techniques of conducting fire and life safety inspections with emphasis on code compliance. Gain the skills and knowledge to inspect and perform fire alarm/fire sprinkler system acceptance testing. Identify fire and life safety hazards and violations and apply the correct fire code provisions to address the hazard(s).

FIRE INVESTIGATION FOR FIRST RESPONDERS

Introduces the requirement of National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 921 and is designed specifically to provide a clear definition of the role of first responders in fire investigation and provides essential knowledge to recognize the potential of intentionally set fires, preservation and protection of evidence, and proper reporting of information to appropriate officials. Training is supported with live burn cell investigations and demonstrations. 16-hour credit through National Fire Association (NFA).

ENHANCED WILDLAND FIRE OBSERVATION AND ORIGIN SCENE PROTECTION FOR FIRST RESPONDER (FI-110)

The primary objective of this course is to provide instruction in accurate wildland fire observation techniques and origin-scene protection practices, enabling first responders to properly secure and preserve wildland fire origin areas. Course delivery incorporates concise lectures, electronic instructional modules, field-based practical exercises, and facilitated class discussions.

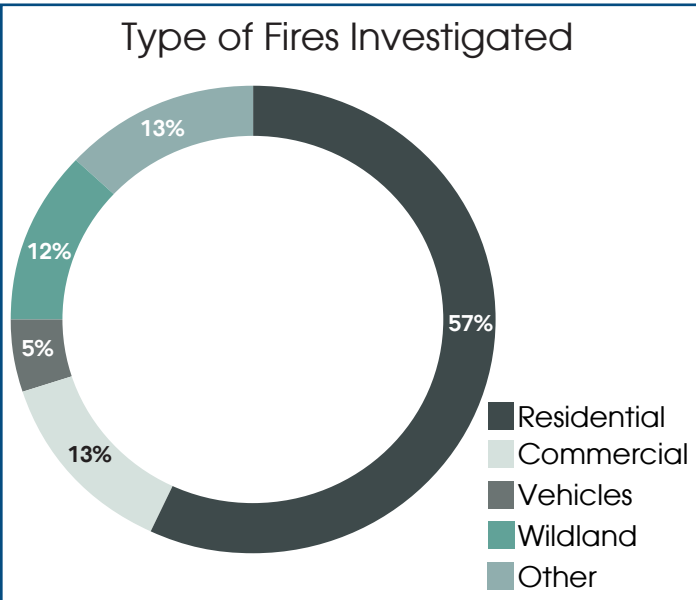
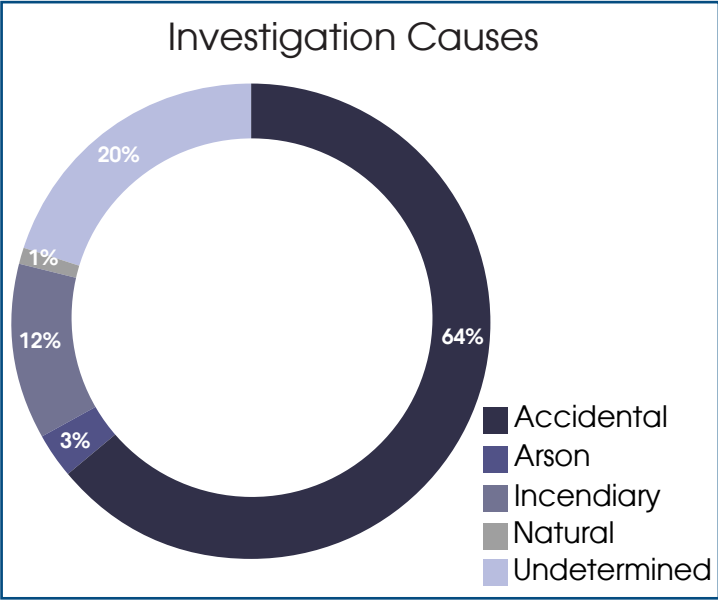
NATIONAL FIRE INCIDENT REPORTING SYSTEM (NFIRS)

Calls Per Month



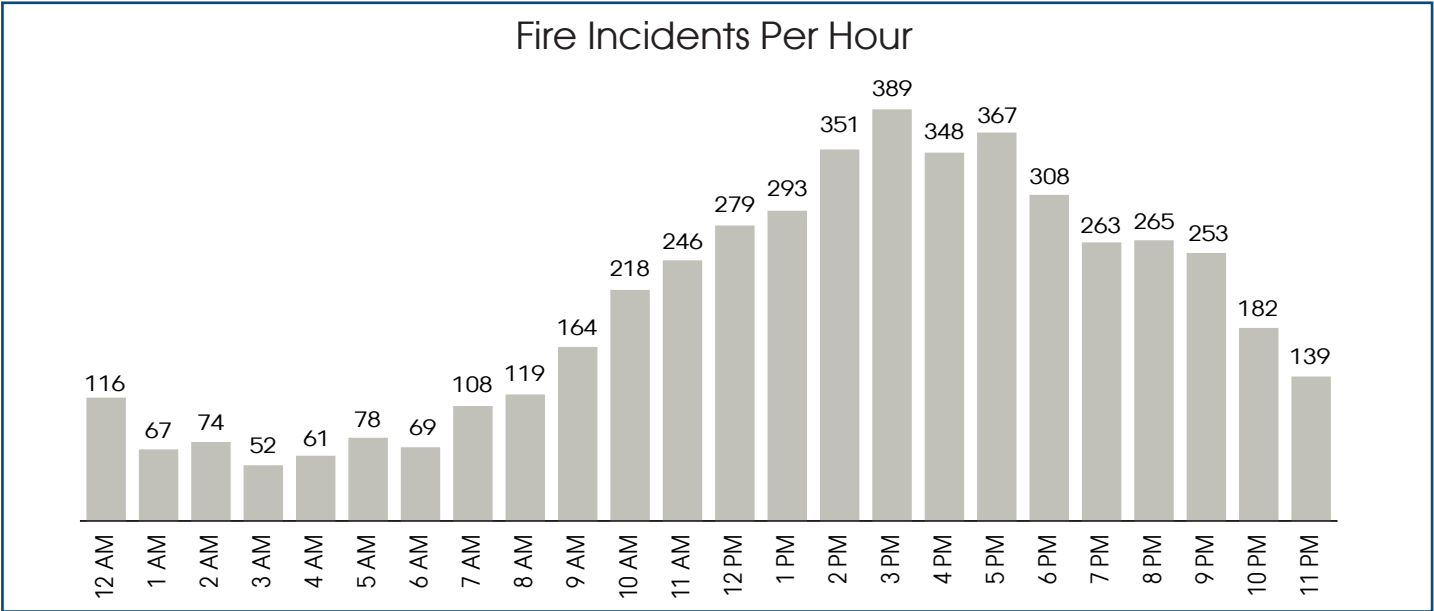

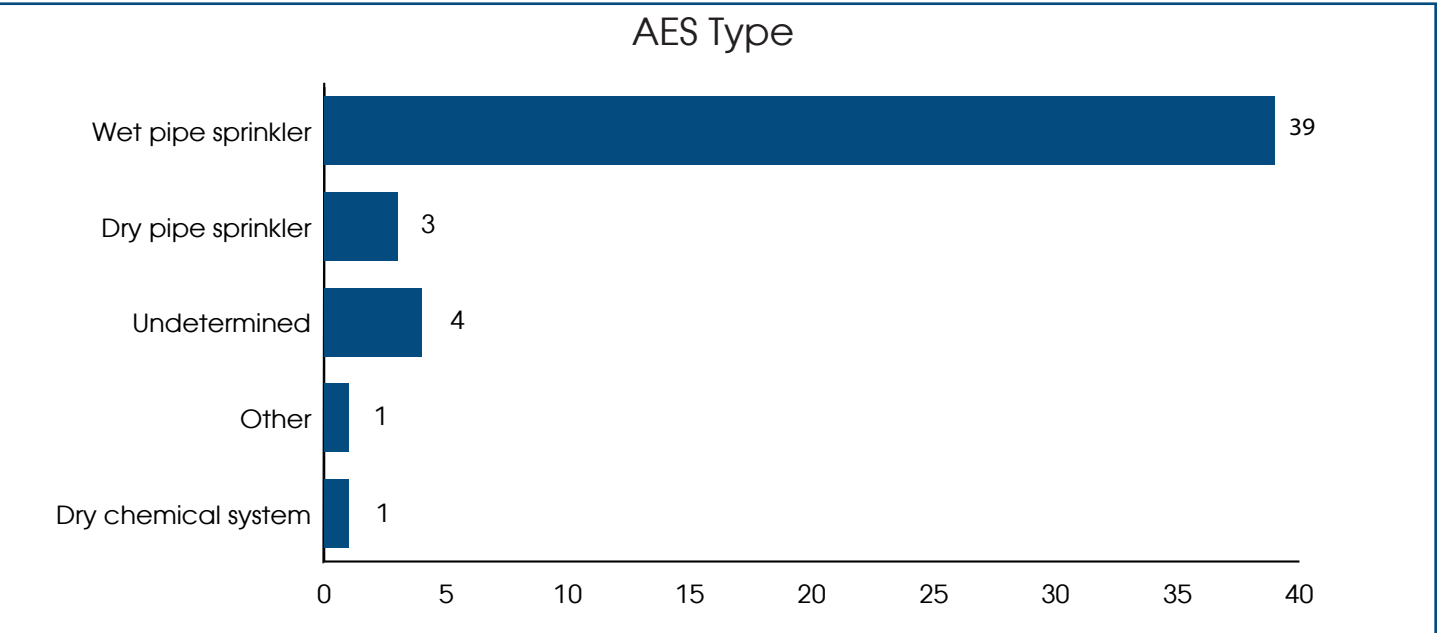
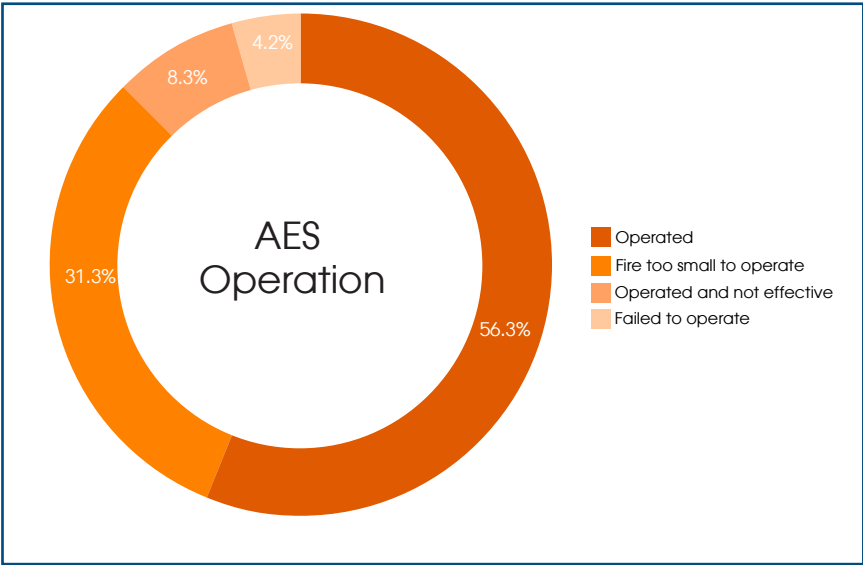
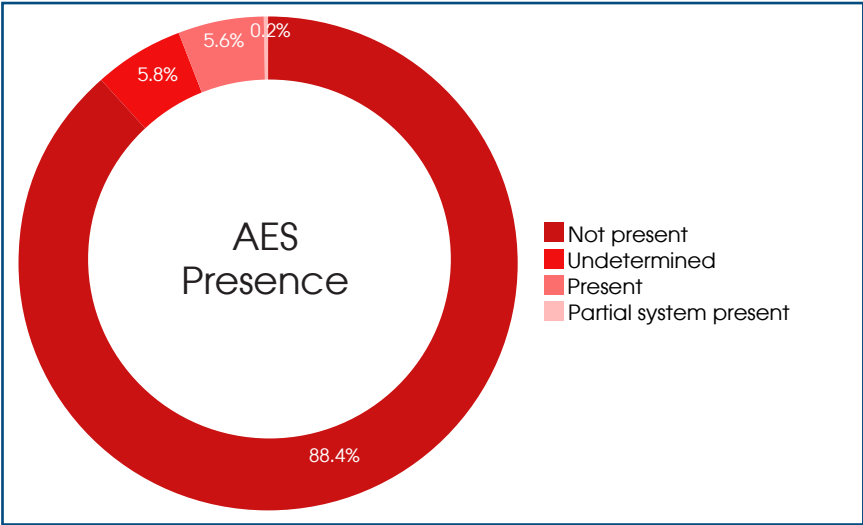
Cause of Fires in Residential
