

ACTIONS TAKEN

FIRE CONTROL OR EXTINGUISHMENT

- 11 Extinguishment by fire service personnel
- 12 Salvage and overhaul
- 13 Establish fire lines around wildlife perimeter
- 14 Contain fire [Wildland] (Includes suppression action that is reasonably to be expected to check fire spread)
- 15 Confine fire [Wildland] (Includes stop the forward progress of a fire but not put in all control lines)
- 16 Control fire [Wildland] (Surrounding the fire perimeter with control lines)
- 17 Manage prescribed fire (Wildland)
- 10 Fire control or extinguishment, other

SEARCH & RESCUE

- 21 Search for lost/missing person(s) or animal(s)
- 22 Rescue, remove from harm (Excludes vehicle extrication)
- 23 Extrication/disentangling of live person
- 24 Recover body or body parts
- 20 Search and rescue, other

EMS & TRANSPORT

- 31 Provide first aid/check for injuries/medical evaluations
- 32 Provide basic life support (BLS)
- 33 Provide advanced life support (ALS)
- 34 Transport of person in a fire service ambulance/apparatus
- 30 Emergency medical services, other

HAZARDOUS CONDITION

- 41 Identification, analyze HazMat
- 42 HazMat detection, monitoring, sampling, and analysis
- 43 HazMat spill control and confinement use of absorbents
- 44 HazMat leak control and containment
- 45 Removed hazards (Includes neutralizing a hazardous condition)
- 46 Decontaminate person or equipment
- 47 Decontamination of area exposed to hazardous materials
- 48 Remove hazardous materials
- 40 Hazardous conditions, other

FIRE, RESCUES & HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS

- 51 Ventilate (Includes odor removal and smoke)
- 52 Forcible entry by fire service
- 53 Evacuate area
- 54 Identify/monitor non-hazardous products
- 55 Establish safe area
- 56 Provide air supply
- 57 Provide light or electrical power
- 58 Operate apparatus or vehicle
- 50 Fire, rescue, hazardous condition service, other

SYSTEMS & SERVICES

- 61 Restore municipal services (Includes notifying utility company to turn back on)
- 62 Restore sprinkler or fire protection system
- 63 Restore fire alarm system
- 64 Shut down system (Includes shutting down water, gas, and fire alarm systems)
- 65 Secure properties (Includes covering holes in roofs and broken windows)
- 66 Removed water or control flooding condition
- 60 System and services, other

ASSISTANCE

- 71 Assist physically disables (Includes nonmedical assistance to physically disabled, handicapped or elderly)
- 72 Assist animals
- 73 Provide manpower (Includes assist lifting patients or providing manpower to assist police)
- 74 Provide apparatus (Excludes normal fire suppression operations)
- 75 Provide equipment to another agency
- 76 Provide water, non-fire suppression
- 77 Control crowd, not vehicles
- 78 Control traffic
- 79 Assess damage of severe weather/natural disaster
- 70 Assistance, other

INFORMATION, INVESTIGATION, & ENFORCEMENT

- 81** Incident command
- 82** Notify other agencies (Includes utility companies, property owners, etc.)
- 83** Provide information to public or media
- 84** Refer to proper authority (Includes turnover incidents to BLM, Forest Services and Police)
- 85** Enforce fire code and other codes
- 86** Investigate
- 87** Investigate, fire out on arrival
- 80** Information, investigation, and enforcement other

FILL-IN, STANDBY

- 91** Fill-in, move up to another fire station
- 92** Standby
- 93** Canceled en route
- 90** Fill-in, standby, other
