



# ASSISTING AN EMS CREW

It is recommended to fill out all fields for a comprehensive incident report.

## Modules

<b>Mandatory:</b>	Basic
<b>Mandatory if occurs:</b>	Fire Service Casualty
<b>Recommend if occurs:</b>	EMS
<b>Optional:</b>	Apparatus/Personnel

The difference between Assisting an EMS Crew (**311**) and running an EMS call (**321-324**) is patient care. If your department does NOT provide patient care, then it is an Assist, including Lift Assists.

**Incident Types:**           **311** – Medical Assist, assist EMS Crew

**Action Taken:**           **34** – Transport of person from scene in an apparatus  
                                  **71** – Assist physically disabled  
                                  **73** – Provide Manpower

### Basic Module

- Alarm, Arrival, and Last Unit Cleared dates/times.
- Mutual Aid
- Resources
- Property Use
- Narrative

### EMS Module (Recommended)

- Date/Time
- Provider Impression/Assessment
- Age of Patient
- Gender
- Human Factors (if applicable)
- Body Site & Injury Type (up to 5)
- Cause of Illness/Injury
- Initial Level of Provider

\*Must complete one module per patient.
