It is recommended to fill out all fields for a comprehensive incident report.

Modules

Mandatory: Basic

Mandatory if occurs:

Fire Service Casualty

Recommend if occurs:

EMS

Optional: Apparatus/Personnel

The difference between Assisting an EMS Crew (311) and running an EMS call (321-324) is patient care. If your department does NOT provide patient care, then it is an Assist, including Lift Assists.

Incident Types: 311 – Medical Assist, assist EMS Crew

Action Taken: 34 – Transport of person from scene in an apparatus

71 – Assist physically disabled

73 – Provide Manpower

EMS Module (Recommended)

- Date/Time
- Provider Impression/Assessment
- Age of Patient
- Gender
- Human Factors (if applicable)
- Body Site & Injury Type (up to 5)
- Cause of Illness/Injury
- Initial Level of Provider
