It is recommended to fill out all fields for a comprehensive incident report.

Modules

Mandatory: Basic

Mandatory if occurs:

Civilian or Fire Service Casualty

(Civilian Module if it's in your jurisdiction)

Recommend if occurs:

Fire

Optional: Apparatus/Personnel

The pile can consist of trees, trash, tree limbs, weeds, old wood, etc. If the pile extends to a structure, an exposure report is required for the structure. If the pile extends to a pasture or open land, the Fire Module is recommended.

Incident Types: 151 – Outside, rubbish, trash or waste

Actions Taken: 11 – Extinguish

87 - Investigate, Fire out on arrival

Basic Module

- Alarm, Arrival, and Last Unit Cleared dates/times.
- Mutual Aid.
- Resources
- Record damage to vegetation, crops, etc. if the fire spreads. Estimated Dollar Losses & Values are estimates and are required for all fires.
- Property Use
- Narrative

Fire Module

- Acres Burned
- Area of Origin
- Heat Source
- · Item First Ignited
- Type of Material First Ignited
- Cause of Ignition (intentional, unintentional)
- Factors Contributing to Ignition
- Human Factors Contributing to Ignition
- Equipment Involved

Civilian Fire Casualty Module

Complete if the civilian is in your jurisdiction. Fire departments giving aid is always None. Complete one module for each civilian injured/death)

Fire Service Casualty Module

Completed when an injury, death, *or* exposure to your own Fire Service Personnel occurs in any incident. One module should be completed for each person if there are multiple injuries, deaths, or exposures.
