



PROVIDING MUTUAL AID

(MUTUAL AID GIVEN)

Modules

Mandatory:	Basic
Mandatory if occurs:	Fire Service Casualty
Optional:	Apparatus/Personnel

This only applies when you physically arrive and work the scene to aid the fire department's jurisdiction.

This does NOT apply to assisting EMS agencies or police.

If you are cancelled enroute then no aid was involved. You must physically be at the scene.

If your department responds to a Mutual Aid call and only your department arrived at the scene, the Aid Given must be coded as **5 – Other Aid** and complete the report as no aid was given.

If your department is responding to an Idaho Department of Lands, BLM or Forest Service jurisdiction, you must code it as **5 – Other Aid** and complete the report as no aid given.

Incident Type: Use the Incident Type you arrived to

Basic Module

- Alarm, Arrival, and Last Unit Cleared dates/times.
- Mutual Aid. When you are giving mutual aid to another fire department and you arrived on scene, code **Aid Given**. If you are assisting EMS agencies or police, code as **None**.
- Resources
- Property Use
- Narrative

Civilian Fire Casualty Module

If a Civilian Fire Casualty (injury or fatality) occurs due to the fire and your department is providing the aid, the department Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) is responsible for completing the module. **Do not** fill this module out if your department is providing the aid.

Fire Service Casualty Module

This module is required when an injury, death, or exposure to the department's own Fire Service Personnel because of an incident.

(One module should be completed for each person if there are multiple injuries, deaths, or exposures)
